

In October of this year, you received the first Faithful Finances newsletter. If you did not receive your Faithful Finances newsletter, contact the office, and we will make sure you are on the list. This newsletter is a quarterly newsletter that will be communicating with you about all things, finances and stewardship as it relates to the local church and our life together. Since the publication of the first Faithful Finances newsletter, I have been asked about a financial update about the reality that we were facing an \$85,000 deficit in the final quarter of 2023. In that newsletter, I also encouraged you, as we were coming into the year-end, to consider making a year-end gift to the ministry of the local church. Although January will be the next edition of Faithful Finances, I wanted to give you an update and also clarify some things since that October publication.

A question was asked, how are things different this year than last year? Well, over half of the shortfall of this year is a result of two things. First some very generous members have moved away or died. That giving does not replace itself immediately. The majority however came as a result of our budgeting for the solar to have been completed. We anticipated a \$25,000 savings this year that was not realized. The total in that shortfall was nearly \$50,000. As I stated in the October Financial newsletter, this is not sustainable for the long-term.

Since the October newsletter, the GVCC Foundation in response to the Faithful Finances newsletter, made a one-time distribution of \$19,600. The amount of \$7,600 was given to support the ongoing radio broadcast ministry of UMCGV. Historically this had been done but had been overlooked in recent years. The remaining \$12,000 was given for administrative support as both Lou Schellhaas serves as the financial administrator and Deanne Handlong serves with administrative assistance for the GVCC Foundation.

We have just completed our 2024 Stewardship campaign and hope that if you have not turned in your Estimate of Giving Card you would consider doing so soon. We have work to do and look ahead to all that God is doing among us!




Join us for Fellowship on Zoom Sundays after 10:15 worship

The "camp" provides an overview of the history, organizational structure, and the many opportunities for service and witness available at UMC of Green Valley.

Neil Hinton Award



Esperanza Memory Café!

With funding support from Pima Council on Aging (PCOA), our church just launched its first Memory Café as part of our Caring thru Dementia ministry. Because our church is located on Esperanza Boulevard and because we want to welcome participation from the community, we decided to name it "Esperanza Memory Café." ("Esperanza" means "hope" in Spanish.)

Memory café is an innovative approach towards ending the isolation those experiencing memory loss and their caregivers often feel. Described as a "welcoming place," memory café is a one-hour program with music, snacks, storytelling, and activities in a safe, supportive, and fun environment.

Our first Memory Café, launched as a pilot program November 15, was "Thanksgiving Memories" with Pastor Doug as emcee and Linda Truesdell as musician. Beginning this month and continuing through 2024, Esperanza Memory Cafes will be held on the second Thursday of the month at 2:00 pm. Trained volunteers will be designing and hosting each gathering.
